New Electronic Billing : Pilot Program

In our last newsletter we reminded our users of how many 'other' plans beside DMERC that can be billed. The response was *great*, clients have signed up to send claims previously filed on paper claims.

However, some plans requested were not on our payer list. Asking our 'clearinghouse' to add a plan isn't an easy task,, they use the old adage you know'the squeaky wheel....'

With a little research we found, tested and began with a second clearinghouse to fill in many of the missing payors. We have successfully processed claims for a client and are now seeking more clients wishing to **save money!**

There is a lot of work to be done, such as automating reports and more. There are some advantages as well. They offer a live edit / fix ability used before the claims are sent. Plus the ability to accept more WEBMD (NEIC) plans. And bringing on new plans is accepted with open arms.

DMEFree / PC Solutions is seeking clients to review the new payer list at <http://dmefree.com/newpayors.htm> Find plan's you wish to bill electronically and contact our office at support@dmefree.com We will work with you to setup a per claim discount (under **\$.50**) for these claims. **DMERC plans and plans we already process do not qualify for this program.**

Although this is a pilot program, we can assure you that your claims will not be lost or not billed. However the paperwork you receive may need some adjustments over time. Additionally we may request these 'pilot' payors be sent to our clearinghouse separately from your other claims so mix-ups are kept to a minimum. ***We are looking forward to hearing from you!***
